INTRODUCTION TO PUNNETT SQUARES

Today make it a point to memorize the following:

<u>Homozygous Dominant</u> = two capital letters=TT

<u>Homozygous Recessive</u> = two lowercase letters =tt

Heterozygous = a capital and a lowercase= Tt

FACT: if a capital letter is present it is always the winner

FACT: in order for a lower case letter to be the "winner" you must have 2 of them


Genotype: what the genes look like, Example = tt

EXAMPLE CROSS:




