- 14. DRAW ARROWS TO SHOW HOW NUCLEAR POWER IS TURNED INTO ELECTRICAL POWER (5pts)

Electric energy is created and flows through wires to your home.

The motion energy of turbine blades spins a coil of wires near a magnet. The magnetic field starts pushing electrons.

The kinetic energy of steam allows it to spin blades (turbine).

Water molecules increase in speed so much that they become steam.

Uranium atoms are split into smaller atoms (FISSION).

Heat from the fission reaction is used to heat up water.
