<u>20</u>	Food web- diagram showing feeding relationships in an ecosystem
21	Energy pyramid - diagram that shows energy loss in an environment
22	Limiting factors - a resource that is so scarce that it limits the size of a population [food, water in a desert, space]
23	Carrying capacity - the largest population that an environment can support
24	Competition - when 2 or more organisms try to use the same resource.
<u>25</u>	Predator_the eater (carnivore)
<u>26</u>	Prey-the victim

<u>27</u>	Symbiosis- a close long term association between 2 or more species
<u>28</u>	Mutualism - both organisms benefit (good)
<u>29</u>	Commensalism - one organism benefits and the other is unaffected

32	<u>Host</u> -the victim of the parasite
